Children's Bibles & activity bags are available in the Koinonia Room.

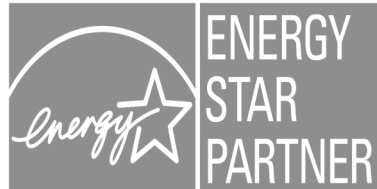
