

# Our Covenant

*Revised to reflect the latest CDC guidance*

Let's continue to show our love for each other by taking the following steps to keep each other safe.

## Responsibilities of People Attending In-Person Worship and Other Church Activities:



**If you have any symptoms** of COVID-19, do not enter the church building.

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea



**If you are not fully vaccinated\*** for any reason and have been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 or who has symptoms, **remain at home** and consult your health care provider before attending in person.



**Maintain physical distancing** of 6 feet at all times (couples and families who live together do not need to distance).



**Wear a mask** to cover your nose and mouth at all times while inside the church building.



**Frequently wash or sanitize your hands.**



**If you begin to sneeze or cough repeatedly** during worship, exit the sanctuary, and an usher will be there to assist.

## Responsibilities of Trinity Lutheran Church:

- **Provide virtual options**, including Sunday worship live on YouTube and via radio on Lakes 92.7.
- **Maintain a well-ventilated and clean spaces.**
- **Facilitate physical distancing and provide masks.**
- **Monitor transmission and vaccination data and adjust covenant as needed.**

**\*Fully Vaccinated:** At least 2 weeks after 1-shot regimen (J&J) or after second shot of 2-shot regimen (Pfizer or Moderna).
